#### Drink tap water. Rather than using plastic bottles that might end up in the sea, refill your reusable container from the tap. If you prefer filtered water, use public water dispensers.

#### Leave nothing but footprints.

Our little island can't handle the 5000% spike in waste production in the summer months, so please remember to take your waste with you when you leave. And if you're a smoker, make sure to properly dispose of your cigarette butts in one of our voting ashtrays.

#### Refuse single use plastic.

Refuse single use plastics at shops, supermarkets, and other local businesses. Say no to unnecessary plastic bags, straws, cutlery, bottles, and cups.

## Top tips for getting people to sign the **Citizen Promise**

**Review our Citizen Promise template** and adjust it to your needs. You can make it feel extra special by making sure the Promise references your community by name.

#### **Print out the Promise as a poster.** Put

it up in prominent locations in your community. For example, at the airport, on boats, at tourist offices, at the Municipality, on tourist maps, at hotel receptions, bus stops, shop windows, restaurant & café tables, schools, archaeological sites etc.

#### Include links to useful locations and

resources. If you have a webpage, upload the Promise at a simple URL - eg. www.yourwebsite. com/citizenpromise

Share the Promise via your social media channels, and ask other people and organisations to repost.

If possible, include a QR code on the

printout of the Promise that links to your webpage or social media channels. You should be able to use this to track clicks as well.
